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Target Group

Children aged 2-6 years who have a developmental delay or sensory issues, who require extra support.

What to Expect

Transition support is facilitated by an Early Intervention Consultant with expert knowledge around supporting children who have additional needs coping with change.

Individualised Support programs may include collaboration with parents / families, observation visits, support and training for educators and a detailed, customized transition program.

Aims of the Program

Families can access support around considerations when choosing a school or service in order to maximise their child's inclusion, and to complement their individualised support needs.

Goals of the Program

Goals are individually negotiated with the child, their family and educators.

Outcomes

Children will:

- Be supported to participate to their full potential in an educational setting

Families will:

- Feel confident that the educational setting they have chosen for their child is meeting their needs

Educators will:

- Feel supported and confident in working with students who have transition / sensory issues
