Target Group

Children aged 4-6 years who are experiencing emotional or social behavioural difficulties. The Program includes parenting education to consolidate the Stop Think Do concepts.

What to Expect

The Stop, Think, Do Program is facilitated by an Early Intervention Consultant with expert knowledge around supporting children who have additional social and emotional needs.

Aims of the Program

The Stop, Think, Do Program aims to develop children's emotional and social intelligence, as they learn how to understand and control their feelings.

Goals of the Program

Children learn about how to STOP and control feelings, THINK about options and consequences and DO - make better choices.

Outcomes

Children will:

- Be supported to enhance their relationships, both with peers and their Parents / Carers

Parents / Carers will:

- Feel confident and motivated to use the programs to manage children's behaviour
